SHRED-IT EVENT



**It's that time of year again!
Dispose of all of your unwanted large/bulky items
and old paperwork in one day!**

Items for the **large item pick up** need to be placed **curbside by 6 a.m. Saturday morning**. Accepted items are listed on the back of this flyer. This is a Waste Management event only. City Union Mission will not be participating.

The **shred event** will take place in the **police bay parking lot behind City Hall**. The event is from **9 a.m. – 12 p.m.** If the shred truck fills up before noon, the event will end earlier. No limit on shredding. Boxes will be returned to you once items are deposited securely in the shred truck. **To avoid traffic congestion, please pull alongside the curb on the east side of the road and wait until a staff member directs you to pull in front of the shred truck.**

Bulk items collection guidelines

Note: Bulk item collections services are designed to collect a limited number of large singular items. It is not designed as an additional household trash collection.

Accepted Items for collection

- Furniture (sectional furniture must have pieces separated).
- Appliances such as washing machines and clothes dryers. No FREON items, like refrigerators freezers or ice makers.
- Lawnmowers, which must be empty of any fuel or oil.
- Barbeque grills- NO propane tanks.
- Carpeting, cut and tied into rolls no longer than 6 feet
- Mattresses and box springs (please wrap in plastic if soiled for safe handling).

Not accepted Items for collection

- Hazardous waste: flammable, corrosive, explosive, toxic or radioactive materials including engine oil or fuel tanks.
- Automotive batteries
- Tires or rims.
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Glass panels where any dimension exceeds four feet
- Brush or tree limbs.
- Latex or oil-based paint.
- Fertilizer, pesticide, solvent.
- Liquid waste.
- Solid waste and recycling material that are collected as part of regular curbside disposal service.
- Any waste or material that is prohibited from being received, managed or disposed of at a landfill or by the city/county/state.
- Riding lawnmowers.
- Wood fencing and decking materials.
- Construction debris.
